

## LANCASTER FELLWALKERS March 15th 2020

Spring was in the air for Lancaster Fellwalkers' outing on Sunday to Haworth. After all the recent storms and gales, they enjoyed a largely dry day with extensive views down the Pennines.

David Ward started first with the A+ group from Boundary Mill in Colne, went up to Walton's Monument, along the Pennine Way and Bronte Way to Lad Law, Great Saucer Stones and Crow Hill, and into Haworth via Top Withins, covering 15 miles and 2,300 feet of ascent.

Two groups started next from Laneshaw Bridge. Judith Brown led the B Group through Wycoller, and along the Bronte Way to Water Sneddles and Ponden Reservoirs and Buckley Farm, also visiting Bronte Falls and Bridge, 9 ½ miles and 1550 feet. Kate Brindley went with the A- group along a similar route, but also went over Sandy Hill, to Top Withins and Harbour Lodge, 12 ½ miles and 1800 feet.

Sue Barrett took the A Group on a circular walk from Haworth, starting from Penistone Country Park, along the Pennine Way to Top Withins and Wadsworth Moor to Wadshaw then back via Lumb Hole waterfall, 13 miles and 2300 feet.
